New Delhi: The opposition parties have decided to field a joint candidate to contest against the government nominee for the Vice-President's post. However, unlike the Presidential elections where the opposition parties came together and declared Yashwant Sinha as their joint candidate even before the NDA's decision, the Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) has decided to finalise their candidate only after the ruling alliance announces the name that it proposes for the post, according to sources.

The opposition wants to ensure its candidate matches the stature and profile of the NDA nominee, so that the contest does not become one-sided as it seems to be happening with the Presidential race as Murmu's credentials as a tribal and a woman have been questioned from the rival camp switch sides. Hence, the opposition hopes to challenge the ruling alliance for the VP contest.

Paddy sowing area in kharif season down 17%

New Delhi: Kharif (summer crops) sowing operation, which saw a sluggish start due to heavy monsoon deficit in June, has now picked up pace, taking the total acreage to cross the last year's corresponding period figure for the first time this season even as sown area under paddy continues to be in deficit.

According to officials' acreage this week is however, the highest takeoff from the sown-area data released by the agriculture ministry on Friday. Its acreage figure shows that oilseeds recovered from 29% down to July 8 to 7% up to July 15 compared to its corresponding period seven years ago.

Overall higher acreage of kharif crops this week is, in fact, attributed to the substantial jump in the oilseeds sown

area which is also in sync with the government's focus on oilseeds to reduce import bills.
